Student Travel

Policy Statement

The Strait Regional School Board recognizes the value of curriculum-based events, field trips, tours and sports trips and encourages schools to consider these experiences as an important part of enriching student learning and instruction.

Guidelines

1. In the implementation of this policy and supporting procedures, schools must adhere to relevant legislation, policies and procedures, including but not limited to:
 - *Education Act and Regulations Under the Act*
 - *Motor Carrier Act*
 - Department of Education and Early Childhood Development *Use of Instructional Time Policy*
 - Department of Education and Early Childhood Development *Physical Education Safety Guidelines*
 - Strait Regional School Board *Use of Instructional Time Policy III-B-6* and supporting procedures, PRO III-B-6
 - Strait Regional School Board *Transportation Contract Services Policies IX-C-1 to IX-C-5*
 - Provincial School Code of Conduct Policy
 - Strait Regional School Board *Volunteers in the School*, Policy VI-C-1 and supporting procedures, PRO VI-C-1
 - Strait Regional School Board *School-Based Funds Policy VII-A-3* and supporting procedures, PRO VII-A-3
 - Nova Scotia School Athletic Federation Handbook

2. This policy applies to all students, staff, volunteers, schools and school groups taking part in curriculum-based events, field trips, tours and sports trips under the jurisdiction of the Strait Regional School Board.

3. The safety of students, staff and volunteers is the number one priority when planning and approving curriculum-based events, field trips, tours and sports trips.
